



A key milestone in finding the will of our Lord for our project is knowing what the Diocese will permit on our current site. Ideally, we would like the buy the site outright, a workable option two is ownership is retained with permission to do as we see fit. If neither of these are agreeable, we look to plan B an alternative site. To this end Steve Rees has written to the Diocese outlining our plans, so please pray:

That the letter gets to and is read by those who are key to making the decision. That there would then be an opportunity to meet in person to discuss the proposals That our plans will find favour in their eyes. That through this the Lord clearly shows us our next steps.

Church Of England

On Wednesday the PCC of All Saints and St Richards completed a questionnaire/survey sent by our Bishops asking how the PCC intend to respond to the proposals due to be voted upon at the next General Synod in July. The collated responses from PCC's across our Diocese will then be used to indicate the impact a positive vote in July will have.

Please Pray:

That as the House of Bishops meet, they will engage with the significant proportion of the church that have concerns. For those for whom this is a deeply personal, difficult & complex topic That the CEEC plan for "structural rearrangement" is realistic, heard and taken seriously. For unity and solidarity of Orthodox churches For the Bishops as they meet for discussions – Repent & back down That the proposals will be defeated at the next General Synod in July. For effective provision for orthodox and evangelicals for the future we need "visible differentiation" Titus 3:10 For wisdom in post-July "next steps" financial arrangements locally and across SGP For wisdom in looking into post-july Episcopal oversight should the proposals be carried That God would make the 'seemingly impossible, possible'
